



## Georgia's Favorite Products for Scorpion Control

*You may know my scorpion story and how I know first hand the fears and frustrations of having scorpions in the home. Over ten years I've controlled scorpions on my own property and helped many others. The products listed below are the most effective and have become my favorites. **Contact Spray / Instant Killer:** **Terro—Scorpion Killer or Spider Killer.** Purchase from Lowe's. Look for the orange can with the blue top—products have the same ingredients, they just have different cans and are marketed differently.



**Catcher:** Make your own using a rod/pole/stick and duct tape. At the end of the rod attach a wad of duct tape with the sticky side out (don't use masking tape). This is a great tool if you find a scorpion on the ceiling or wall.

**Traps:** **Non-poisonous** glue traps can be purchased at Lowe's and various other retailers in the garden departments. There are many great uses for these products, but use caution in garages as birds and lizards can become trapped.

**Scorpion Repellents: Non-poisonous & Organic. Best for long term control as they "break" the paths.** These natural products repel scorpions, venomous snakes and an array of non-beneficial insects. These products help repel scorpions and kill insects that succumb to the scent. The lingering aroma is a pheromone interruption agent that impairs the mental capacity of non-beneficial insects. They also damage eggs and larvae reducing future generations of insects such as crickets, roaches, earwigs and many others. Safe for our children, pets and the environment. The products leave a cedar or "woody" smell for us but to insects it's like an ammonia scent. These products are very easy and safe to use—no need to have a pest control technician apply them. I provide specific strategies for use in our Arizona climate and for scorpions. The products are only effective if used properly and should be applied to maintained grounds where vegetation litter is regularly cleaned. These are the primary products I use on my own property which is in a heavily scorpion populated neighborhood.

### Special Uses

**C-Safe Granules**—use instead of Diatomaceous Earth (DE). Never use pool filter DE, it's carcinogenic. Food grade and insecticide grade DE also pose health hazards. Ask me for PestPress to learn the facts.

**C-Safe Interior**—use when leaving your windows open. Spray on sills and screens. Can also be used as a personal use mosquito repellent.

**Fogging Attics**—safer than dusting the attic with poisons that become air borne. Also safer when someone later must crawl in the attic for repairs or if you ever store items in the attic.



**Black Lights: 6 Watt Fluorescent Maglite** also purchase iWare protective goggles and 12" Glo-Grip Tweezers. I've tried a lot of black lights and ScorpionHunter lights are the best products I've found on the market. While the medium 14 LED is fine for small and lightly vegetated properties, I usually recommend the 6 Watt Spot light. Purchase at ScorpionHunter.com or call me, I can usually get them to you at a discount.



**Professional Grade Insecticides: Poisons**—use caution and read the labels carefully if applying yourself.

- **Demand CS** by Syngenta is an Advanced Generation Pyrethroid that has a long residual and is microencapsulated. It is labeled for Scorpion Control at .06% - see label—Don't confuse with the generics!
  - Mix with an additive for flushing and a quick kill. I recommend **Kicker** by Bayer.
- Purchase at doityourselfpestcontrol.com, or call me to order. Can also be purchased at specialty retailers, but is much more expensive. When hiring a technician, I recommend they use these products as well.
